***From Denver:***

Take I-25 South toward Colorado Springs. It's about 108 miles from downtown Denver. Take the exit for Highway 50 toward Canyon City. Turn RIGHT going west. Drive a few miles until you see the signs directing you to make a left toward the reservoir. Make that left. Make a right onto Thatcher. Make a right onto South Marina Road. You'll see the Visitor Center (ranger headquarters) on the right after a short drive. The first morning of the class we'll meet in front of the Headquarters Building at 7:30 am, which you'll see on your right as you enter. The camping ground to the left (Arkansas Point) south of the headquarters is still open, as are the showers (according to the rangers).

***From Boulder:***

It's best to avoid central Denver right now due to T-Rex and traffic. Here's our recommendation. Take Highway 93 (the one along the foothills to Golden). Watch for signs to merge onto C470 headed south toward Colorado Springs. Take the I-25 exit toward DENVER / COLO SPRINGS. Merge onto I-25 S toward COLO SPGS. (95.6 miles). (Note: These directions are obtained from MapQuest. We recommend referring to a map to ensure accuracy!) Take the exit for Highway 50 toward Canyon City. Turn RIGHT going west. Drive a few miles until you see the signs directing you to make a left toward the reservoir. Make that left. Make a right onto Thatcher. Make a right onto South Marina Road. You'll see the Visitor Center (ranger headquarters) on the right after a short drive. The first morning of the class we'll meet in front of the Headquarters Building at 7:30 am, which you'll see on your right as you enter. The camping ground to the left (Arkansas Point) south of the headquarters is still open, as are the showers (according to the rangers).
